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Dear Parents/Guardians,

This week has definitely flown with Monday a Professional Development day for staff and Tuesday, whilst Melbourne Cup gave us a day off, there remained quite a few dedicated staff at school. Monday had all staff working steadily through an array of busy workshops. From the analysis of Attitude to School Survey data, report comment writing, Write to Read literacy program check-in discussions (a program of which all primary staff have been trained, very gratefully funded by parents club) and a fabulous presentation by Liz Campbell. Liz Campbell is well known for her great work with training staff in improving teaching techniques towards assisting students with language delay and dyslexia. Being a very experienced Education Specialist, as well as a Speech and Language Therapist, it was brilliant to have her share her knowledge and allow further learning that we can utilise to assist all of our students. Both language delay and dyslexia can effect working memory. She gave a few tips that all parents can also utilise at home; before reading a book, this should be introduced and explained what the book is about. Read to your child, modelling how the text should sound and then get them to read the text 3-4 times as they will need these chances to completely take in what they have read. When asking questions about the text or any subject, use concrete/literal concepts initially and then build up to more abstract concepts. Whilst this sounds like simple steps, in the hustle and bustle of our busy lives at school and home, it is these simple steps that we often need reminding. This is only scraping the surface of what Liz Campbell introduced to staff of whom have already begun to test their learnt teaching strategies with their students.



Wednesday afternoon Tallangatta hosted the CFA Graduation presentation for the Year 10 CFA crew. It was the Towong 10 crew, that is made up of the three schools involved in CFA and included a few of our students (Tiarnee Hunt, Sophie Hewatt, Buckley Wilson, and Josh Beer), won the CFA Cluster Crew Annual Team Championship. Claudia McKimmie, for her demonstrated leadership and community skills, was the proud recipient of the Bruce Vine Award. It was fantastic afternoon that celebrated the great dedication that our Corryong College crew have demonstrated all year in building skills and great capacity in the CFA. We congratulate them all and there great efforts and thank Ms Nat Lebnor for her continued efforts in ensuring the coordination of these events, as well as her great support for our students, always going above and beyond. 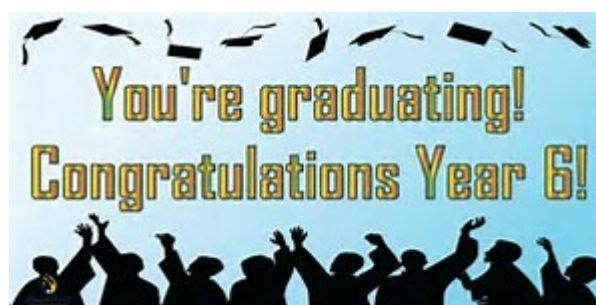
