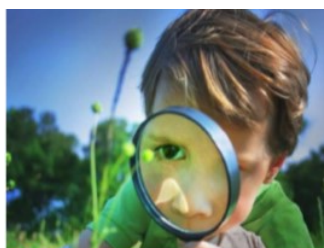

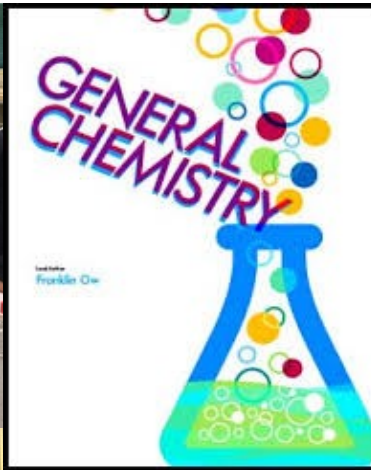


**FallsCreek**
