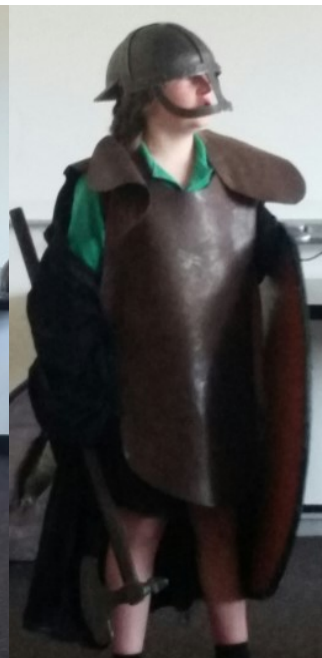










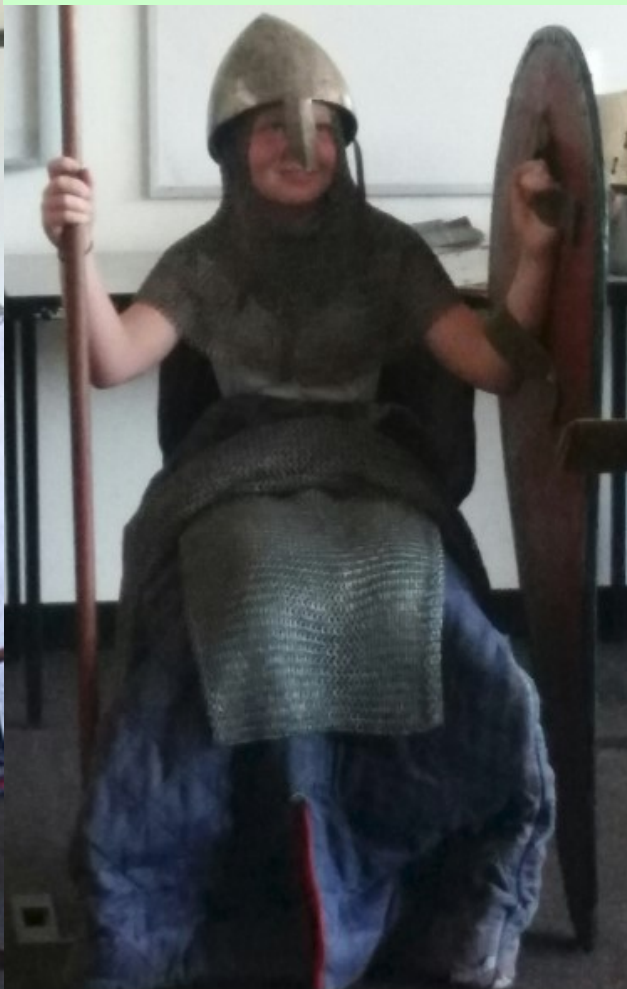


# MEDIEVAL DAY
