B Block toilets and Year 9 lunch room (B1/B2) upgrade

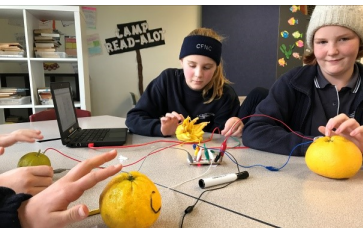

Musical Fruit



Year 5/6 have experimented with their new makey makey kits; a programming kit that allows electrical current to pass through various objects. Each group, clipped the alligator clips between the makey makey board (circuit board), their chosen object, of which they chose fruit, their finger for the earth which created the electric current and thirdly, the cord into their computer. This allowed the students to program the sounds made from electrical currents of which they were able to create particular sounds by tapping each varying piece of fruit. The classes collaborated and made melodies using their fruit and makey makey kits. This was phenomenal to witness and I congratulate all the students on their experimentation, their patience with each other and the depth of knowledge they

explored in creating electrical currents through varying methods.
