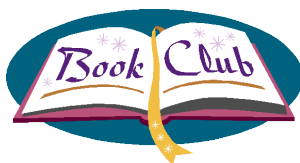

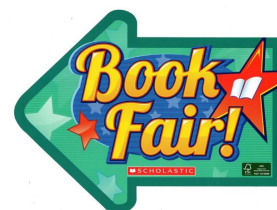

Professor Bunsen to visit Corryong.

On Friday the 12th of May students from Years F to 12 will have the opportunity to attend the amazing Professor Bunsen's Science Show. This will take place in the Hub with students from Year 5 to 8 attending the morning sessions, F to 4 in the mid-morning and 9 to 12 in the afternoon.

The cost of the excursion is only \$6 per student and needs to be paid to the Office by Friday the 12th.

This interactive presentation focuses on a number of interesting & fun colour and gas producing reactions from the kitchen, laundry, toy shop and bathroom. We will discover the difference between physical & chemical changes and reversible & irreversible changes. Students see & help with instant colour changes, discover the "chemical power" of laundry materials when an explosive balloon is produced, find out how heat packs work and get into nappy science. We will also have some "controlled explosions" and fast burning reactions and many more. Hey, this is exciting stuff!
