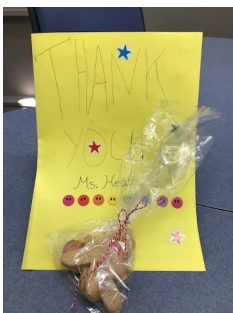


2018 CFA Crew Announced!
