War on Waste - Class 5/6's Challenge to Lesson College Waste

Year 5/6 have been working hard to develop group initiatives with the aim to create greater awareness across the college in minimising waste across the College community. Year 5/6's challenge has been interesting as they review the litter that exists from food packages and paper waste. The groups have a number of projects already commencing whilst others are getting out in the community to seek support. Posters have been designed to create greater awareness around the College and a bin audit has been completed with data informing their action plans. The Year 5/6s already have some brilliant ideas that include;

- Wrap free days; a day a week where food wrappers are banned, with the intention of increasing these days.
- Increasing number of recycle bins and/or food collection bins where food scraps are taken to the chooks.
- Allocating year groups to specific yard areas where that particular year level is responsible for that area. The Year 5/6 classes are seeing this as an opportunity for some healthy competition whilst promoting a clean and tidy environment.
- Creating fun bins where basketball rings could be put over bins to ensure some fun litter collection and maybe some challenges also.



AEDC (Australian Early Development Census) - An Australian Government Initiative for Schools of Foundation Students.

Between now and August this year, our College will be taking part in the Australian Early Development Census, which is a nationwide census of early childhood development and helps early childhood schools and community understand how children are developing before they start school, what is being done well, and what can be improved. The AEDC is an Australian Government initiative run by the Department of Education and Training.

Children do not need to do anything to be included in the census and will attend class as usual. During the census, teachers record information (including children's names and dates of birth) based on their knowledge and observations of each child in their class. The questions to be used by the AEDC in the upcoming collection are available at www.aedc.gov.au/instrument.

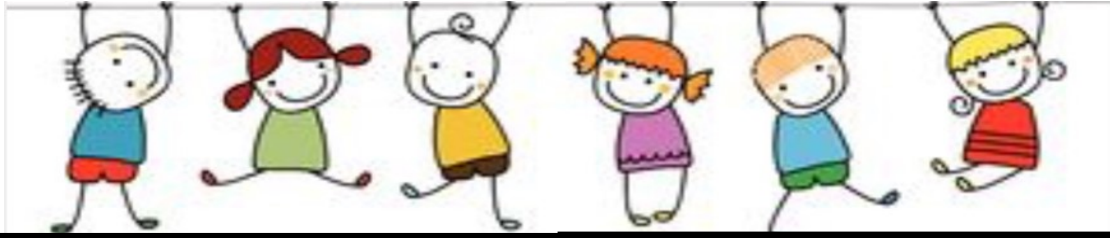

- **CVC**
- **Closed Syllable**

If the word has both of these items then we double the last consonant before adding **-ed or -ing**

Eg. hop + ed = hopped
