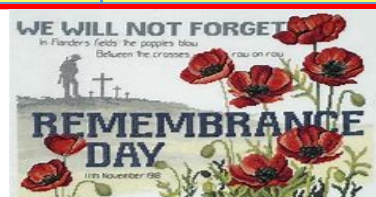

PHONICS CODE OF THE WEEK

2 + 1 + 1 Rule

In the 2 + 1 + 1 rule the following questions are asked prior to adding a suffix:

Is the word a two (or more) syllable word?

Does the word end in one consonant after one short vowel?

Is the accent on the final syllable?

Does the suffix begin with a vowel?

***NOTE:** if all 4 questions are answered with a “yes,” the final consonant is doubled prior to adding the suffix.

Here are some examples:

begin = beginning

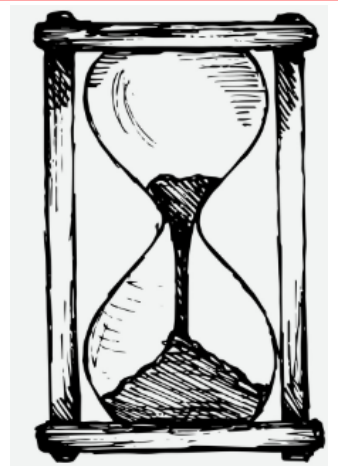
